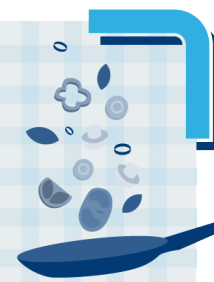

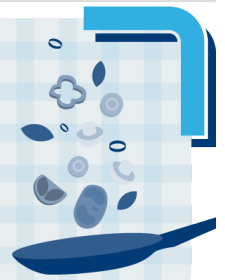

Serving Equipment

From the stove to the plate, there is a stretch that can be as short or as long as your tools allow. Serving soup with a tenedor is not the same as serving it with a cuchara (fork and spoon in Spanish, BTW). If you don't want to make this mistake by not being able to name silverware correctly, Spanish style, take note of the following terms.
